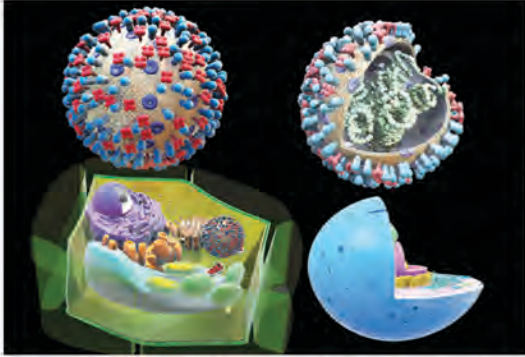

CHILD ABUSE RECOGNITION AND REPORTING TRAINING FOR MANDATED REPORTERS (2 CE) *

Child abuse and neglect is a difficult and sad subject to think and talk about but it is one that we must be prepared to address and be vigilant to prevent. As disturbing as it can be, child abuse and neglect is very real. We can never imagine or understand why an individual commits abuse or neglect. This course will fulfill the two hours of training requirement (Act 31) for license renewal for all mandated reporters by the Pennsylvania State Board of Health.

*Both the child abuse and pain management courses fulfill the two hours of Board approved continuing education as a renewal condition of your professional license. These mandatory courses must be taken every two years.

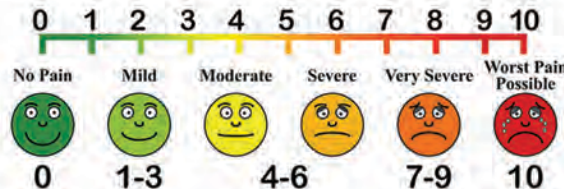


PAIN MANAGEMENT, PRESCRIPTION WRITING, DRUG ADDICTION & RECOVERY SERIES (5 CE)

Perhaps nothing is as simultaneously useful and dreadful as pain. For quite some time, opioids seemed to be the answer to the problem of relieving pain without putting patients at risk of addiction. As it turns out, that was wishful thinking. Excess narcotic prescription writing, substance use and abuse, has devastated many lives. These presentations will cover all Pennsylvania mandated requirements for pain management, identification of addiction and the practice of prescribing or dispensing of opioids as a condition of renewal for practitioners with a DEA license.

- Pain Management: Part I, II, III, IV & V (1 CE each)

Parts I, II and III are mandatory courses for license renewal if you hold a DEA license.

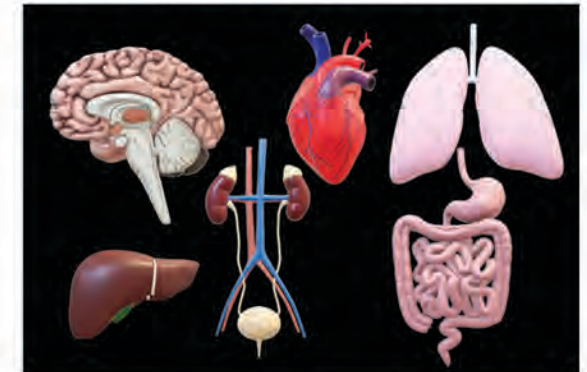
